



Linking to Full-Text Articles in Blackboard

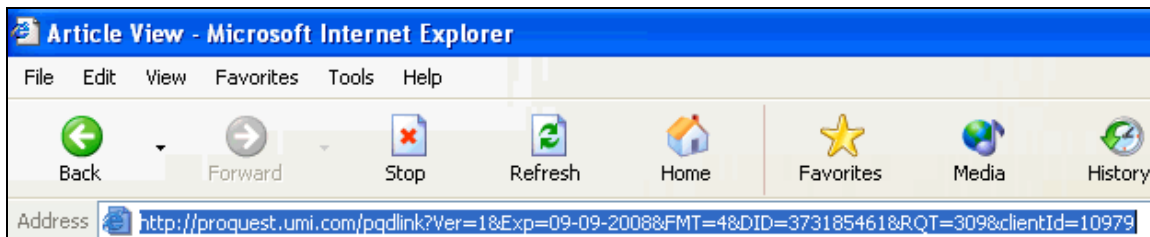
On the web at <http://www.lib.utc.edu/>

Links to full-text articles must be built from an **on-campus location**. Links built from off-campus will not work!

Please note: persistent links to full-text articles in ERIC/EDRS, Lexis/Nexis Academic, and NewsBank are not presently available.

1. Using a web browser, access the database (www.lib.utc.edu/databases) from on-campus and open the article you wish to link to.
2. Highlight the URL for this article as displayed in your browser (see below), and click on Edit / Copy or type Ctrl-C to copy this URL into memory.

Note: if you are using JSTOR, please click on the "Citation/Stable URL" link above the displayed article, then copy the "Stable URL" that appears on the subsequent page which begins with <http://links.jstor.org>...



3. Open Word, Notepad, or another text editor and click on Edit / Paste or type Ctrl-V to paste this copied URL into a new document.
4. In this new document, add <http://proxy.lib.utc.edu/login?url=> at the beginning of an article URL you pasted in. Please take care not to insert any extra spaces in the URLs you build. The revised URL should look like this example:
<http://proxy.lib.utc.edu/login?url=http://proquest.umi.com/pgdlink?Ver=1&Exp=09-09-2008&FMT=4&DID=373185461&RQT=309&clientId=10979>
5. This revised URL is now ready to be copied and pasted into your Blackboard course.
6. When you've finished adding URLs to Blackboard, please log out and close your web browser. Then re-open your web browser, log back into Blackboard, and take a few minutes to test your new links.
